

ANNOUNCEMENT TO THE CLASS OF 1948
CONCERNING COMMENCEMENT

Baccalaureate Service

Sunday, June 13, 11:00 a.m.

Assemble in academic costume in room No. 108, Kauke Hall at 10:30.
Form on the west walk of the Quadrangle ready to march at 10:45 a.m.
Form in order of height; women first.
The class will enter the Chapel first. Pause at the door until the marshals reach the head of the aisle. March to the front and fill the pews indicated by the faculty marshals. Remain standing until the President and others are in place on the platform. At a signal from the President all will be seated. Men will remove their caps (after the President) and keep them off during the service.

When the President reaches the part of his address directed particularly to the class he will indicate the fact; the class will rise (men put on their caps) and remain standing until he indicates that he has finished. The class will again be seated and the men will remove their caps.

Recessional: follow the faculty, women on the front row going first; then men, beginning with the first row.

Alumni Dinner

Saturday, June 12, 6:00 p.m. in Severance Gymnasium.

Seniors will be guests of the Alumni Association on this occasion. The class will assemble with the alumni on the Quadrangle and march to the Gymnasium. Seniors will form on the walk near the commencement platform and will follow the trustees and faculty in the line of march. Each member of the class is asked to come to the Alumni Office for his ticket on and after Tuesday, June 8, and before Saturday, June 12. This ticket will admit to the dinner and dance. It is not now known if there will be tickets available for sale to the parents of seniors. If so, announcement will be made later.

BENEDICTION AND RECESSIONAL

Form on the west walk of the Quadrangle ready to march at 10:15.
Form in alphabetical order, women first. The class will enter first.
March to the seats assigned. Remain standing until the President is
in place and gives the signal for all to be seated. When seated the
men remove their caps and keep them off during the exercises.

When the President is ready to confer degrees, the men put on their
caps. At a signal from the Dean the class will rise. The Dean of the
College presents the class to the President.

The President confers the degrees. (A brief, formal statement.)

Receiving Diplomas: (Women first; a faculty marshal lead the line.)
Ascend the platform at the left side; the Dean will announce your name;
cross to the President; receive the diploma; shake hands with the Pres-
ident; descend at the right and return to the same seat. Remain
standing until the last is again in place and the President gives the
signal to be seated.

Recessional: Stand when the President gives the signal. Fall in behind
the Faculty as the procession leaves. Remain in line and march to the
Quadrangle for the final farewell ceremony; it is customary for the
class to form a circle and sing the Love Song.
