Charter Review Committee Report For 1985-1986

The 1985-1986 Charter Review Committee consisted of Campus Council members Jayne Culp, Julie Ferguson, Lisa Fowerbaugh, Julia Gustafson, and John Toth. The main goal of the Committee this year was to charter every student organization on campus. This project is an attempt to organize and keep accurate records of the groups operating on campus under the provisions set forth in The Scot's Key. Student groups will also be chartered in order to organize the funding process of the Student Government Association (F.A.C.). However, the chartered organizations may or may not request funding. Due to the extent and importance of the chartering project, the Committee finds it necessary to continue the project in the Fall semester of 1986.

All charters reviewed by the Committee were examined, discussed, and corrected if necessary according to their compliance with The Scot's Key, the Guidelines for a Campus Council Charter, and the Policy Regarding Political Activity Within College of Wooster Facilities.
